We've helped thousands of customers with their hydroseeding needs and have had beautiful results, which is why we recommend this method over sod or grass seed lawn installation. Hydroseeding is an efficient, high quality, and inexpensive method of seeding a lawn.



How does it work?

It's the process of combining a mixture called a "slurry" (seed, mulch, fertilizer, soil amendments, and water) in a Hydroseeder tank, and then applying that mixture to the intended surface using high pressure. The hydroseeder keeps the slurry evenly mixed. This causes speedy seed germination and stops erosion in its tracks! In the best scenarios, a new lawn will start to sprout in only a week,

but in most cases, it will take 2-3 weeks to germinate. You will typically see sprouting in 1 to 2 weeks. We all want beautiful, lush lawns to enjoy all summer. That means it's time to start thinking about the best way to achieve that growth before the kids break out the sprinklers and kickball. Hydroseeding is an excellent, affordable option.

When should you do Hydroseeding?

In Michigan, both fall and spring are great times to hydroseed your lawn. Hydroseeding in spring is beneficial because of the moderate temperatures. The spring allows for faster growth than in cooler seasons, but won't require as much water as a lawn that began in the drier summer season.

The ideal temperature for the first 6 weeks after hydroseeding is between 65 and 75 degrees. Temperatures that fall too far outside this window can be harsh and lead to different issues.

The hydroseeding timeline does depend on the weather, but typically, hydroseeded lawns will begin to sprout in 5-7 days. For the next several weeks, they require more care than a regular lawn.

Our Process

1. The truck arrives at the job site, and parks on the street.
2. The operator and helper will do a walk around, surveying the job site to determine how to best set up the equipment for the job.
3. With assistance of the helper, the operator will park the truck accordingly, and pull out the hydroseed hose to begin applying the hydro mulch.
4. The operator and helper will work together to evenly and completely spray the lawn areas.
5. The hydroseed hose will be stored upon completion of the job. The hard surfaces that have overspray from the hydroseed will be swept clean.
6. The operator will provide the homeowner with a Care Brochure, and if the homeowner is available, review the main points of caring for their new lawn.



What types of Grass Seed are available?

Various seed options are available, tailored to each specific project site. Seed for lush turf establishment, MDOT blends for roadside vegetation establishment, pasture seed, athletic field blends, and quality blends for various erosion control solutions are several options Superior provides. High quality starter fertilizer and tackifiers can also be applied during the hydroseeding process to help achieve maximum results.
